Missouri innovation centers work closely with their associated universities and are primarily targeted to develop high-growth advanced technology companies. Innovation Centers provide specialized facilities, access to capital, technical and business experts, resources and specialized service providers to these companies.

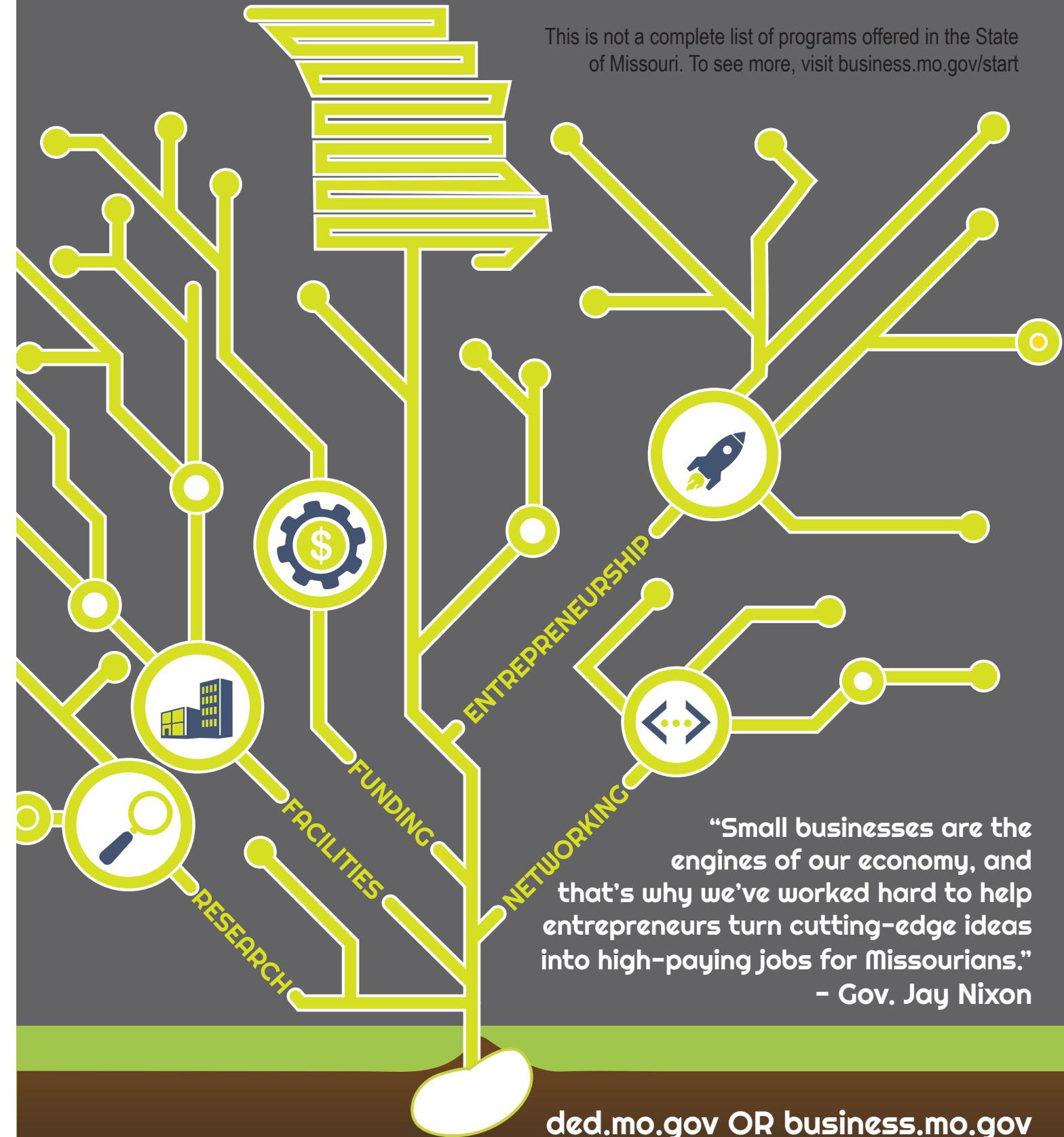
Dean L. Hubbard Center for Innovation and Entrepreneurship - Maryville, MO

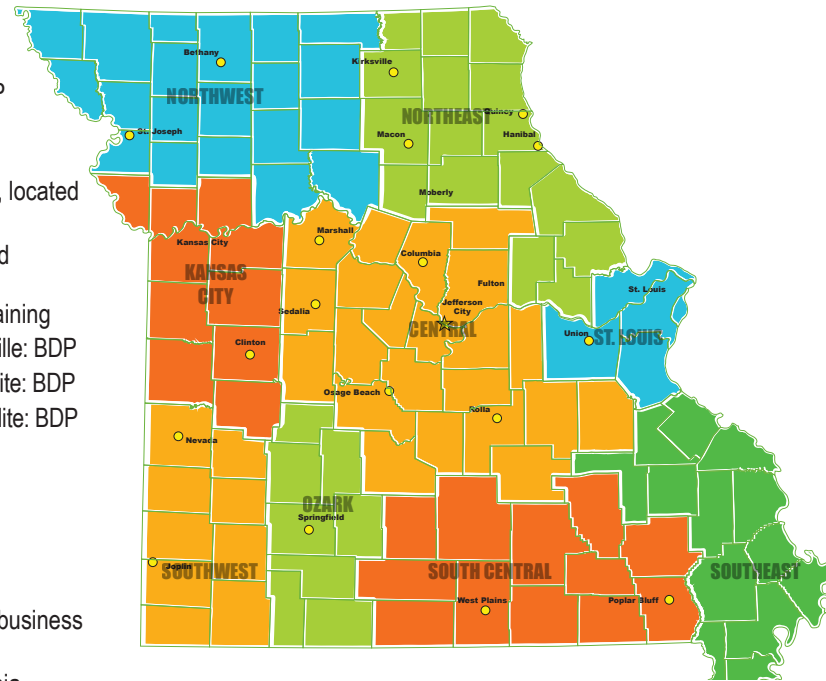

Invest Midwest: venture capital forum
 Missouri Technology Corporation (MTC): a public-private partnership providing seed and venture capital for new and emerging high-tech companies, and grant funding for non-profit entrepreneurial support organizations and research institutions.

Business Development Program (BDP)

The University of Missouri Extension Business Development Program (BDP) is a statewide network which helps businesses succeed through a variety of programs. Programs include:

The Missouri Small Business and Technology Development Centers (MO SBTDC): provide professional business analysis, business consultations, access to technology resources and educational training seminars on a variety of business topics.

The International Trade Center is staffed by a specially trained export team that helps businesses grow by expanding into global markets.

The Missouri Procurement Technical Assistance Centers (MO PTAC): assists businesses — including small, disadvantaged and women owned firms — in obtaining federal, state and local government contracts.

The Mid-America Trade Adjustment Assistance Center (TAAC): equips U.S. manufacturers in three states to proactively respond to import competition.

The Missouri Environmental Assistance Center (MOEAC): pollution prevention, environmental compliance and energy-savings assistance.
