Based on these jobs, the average annual salary someone with a high school diploma will earn is \$25,657. Obtaining an Associates Degree/certificate/apprenticeship puts your average earnings at \$48,489 per year. Those who receive a Bachelor's Degree (a 4-year degree) will make an average of \$71,489, or nearly **THREE TIMES** the amount per year of someone with just a high school diploma.
