

CAREER CREDENTIALS: Many jobs require some form of industry certification on top of a high school diploma (or equivalent) as a prerequisite to hiring. The training involved for certifications is based on industry standards. These certifications are often called credentials. Career credentials show employers that potential candidates are ready to go to work in that particular field.

To be eligible for services, you must: Meet age requirement for programs, reside in Cass, Clay, Jackson, Platte, or Ray Counties (some programs may have specific residential requirements) and meet income guidelines.
