CAN YOU AFFORD UCM?

UCM's financial aid awards help you pay for school. In fact, more than 85 percent of current students receive some type of financial assistance. The university disburses approximately \$80 million annually in federal, state, institutional and private assistance.

Federal and state financial assistance is awarded on the Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) and must be submitted between Jan. 1 and April 1. Awards in the form of grants, student and parent loans, and part-time employment are available based on information provided in the FAFSA.

CAN YOU GET ADMITTED?

Admission of a first-year student is based on a combination of ACT/SAT score, class rank and GPA. To be admitted to UCM, you need to have completed the 24-unit Missouri college preparatory curriculum and have a high school GPA of 2.0 or greater. In addition, you need either:

- A score of 21 or higher on the ACT or 990 on the SAT, or
- A Combined Percentile Index equal to or exceeding 100.
